Scholastic Photo Make Up Day

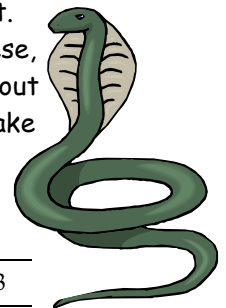

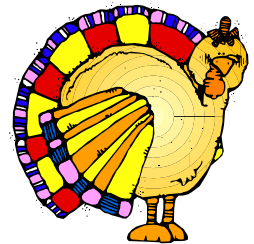
