



## **Community Counseling Program Located at Alice Buffett Magnet Middle School**

The Omaha Public Schools' Board of Education has given approval for continuation of the Community Counseling Program, which benefits students and their families. This Program offers the services of a licensed mental health professional, Kim Mueller, at Alice Buffett Magnet Middle School and at nearby Lord of Love Lutheran Church.

The Community Counseling Program's goal is to bring professional counseling offices closer to where people live and to ensure services are available to all people regardless of their ability to pay. The program is funded by the Methodist Hospital Foundation. Evening hours with Mrs. Mueller are offered at Lord of Love Lutheran Church for those who cannot meet during the day.

Kim Mueller's services at Buffett are limited to Buffett students and their families. Interested students and families may get additional information through the Buffett Guidance Department 561-6160. Except for emergency situations, parent/guardian consent is required before a student starts in the counseling process.

Kim Mueller's services located at Lord of Love Lutheran Church (103 & Fort) are open to the community at large.

No one who receives counseling through the Community Counseling Program will receive a bill for services.

The Program's counselor, Kim Mueller, L.M.H.P., has extensive experience working with youth and families on difficult personal issues such as depression, anger control, interpersonal communication, and school difficulties. Her services are available to anyone who needs help.

This Program is a joint partnership among the Omaha Public Schools, Lord of Love Church, and the Nebraska Methodist Hospital Foundation.
