



Tips for Drivers Dropping Off Students

To ensure that all students arrive at Buffett in a safe and secure manner please take a moment to read through the requests below when transporting your student to school. Ultimately we are all working toward the same goal: getting all Buffett students to school in a safe and timely fashion.

For our parents of 5/6 students:

Please refrain from parking and leaving your car in the right curb lane of the road in front of the main entrance. When you need to walk into the building, we ask that visitors park in the lot and then walk into the school. The curb lane should be used for dropping students off only and not for parking.

For safety, refrain from dropping off your student(s) in the left 'drive through' lane. This practice impedes the parents who are exiting the parking lot and is a serious safety issue for the child who is attempting to cross with the oncoming traffic in the parking lot.

Lastly, be courteous of the other cars in the curb lane when you are dropping off your students. Please refrain from driving ahead of other cars. This will improve traffic flow and student safety. If the right curb lane is used solely for the purpose of dropping off, then the curb lane traffic will move quickly.

For our parents of 7/8 students:

As you drop off students on Larimore Avenue please use the right curb lane. Our School Resource Officer, Officer Mahoney, will be directing traffic at the bus/van circle entrance. Parent vehicles may not enter the bus circle until all the buses have departed and when Officer Mahoney directs you into the circle. Generally, the buses depart by 7:30 am.
