

# Omaha Public Schools Middle Level Activities Contract

## ACADEMIC

1. If a student has three or more "F"s, he/she may not try out for an inter-school athletic team. If a student has two "F"s, he/she may participate in practices only. If, after approximately two weeks the individual has any "F"s, or has not made any improvements, he/she MAY BE dropped from the sport/activity. Students may not compete in games, matches or meets with any "F"s.
2. At the start of each season and/or co-curricular activity, the coach/sponsor will provide a master list of participants to teachers in order to regularly evaluate students' academic progress.

## ATTENDANCE

1. All student participants should be in attendance a minimum of one half the school day (4 of 8 class periods) in order to be eligible to participate in competitions on that day. A physician or dentist note may be required if the absence is due to illness.
2. Students with ten or more days of absence during a given semester may be ineligible to participate following the 10<sup>th</sup> day of absence. The students will remain ineligible through the end of the semester.
3. Students who are truant from school or "skip" a class the day of a contest/event may be ineligible to compete/participate that day. Students with excessive tardies to school may be ineligible to compete/participate in activities at the discretion of the building administration.

## CITIZENSHIP AND BEHAVIOR

1. Student participants who are suspended from school are ineligible to attend practice or participate in competition/events.
2. Student participants assigned to In-School Suspension (I.S.S.) or Suspension After School (S.A.S.) will be ineligible to practice and/or compete on the dates of their I.S.S. or S.A.S. assignment.
3. Cooperation with staff members and the positive representation of \_\_\_\_\_ (school) is essential. Students may be removed from any level of co-curricular activities if they fail to exhibit acceptable behavior.

## PHYSICAL EXAM, INSURANCE COVERAGE, PARENT/STUDENT AGREEMENT

1. A physical examination is required for all students participating in practices and competition related to school athletics. The signature of a licensed physician stating a student is allowed to participated in a school competitive sports program is sufficient. The physical care plan provided by the Omaha Public Schools is recommended, however, it is not the only acceptable plan.
2. Students must have insurance coverage to participate in inter-school athletics.
