# Describe the data that analyzed to determine the effectiveness of the program and decisions made as a result:

We looked at current math and ELA MAP data as well as 2022 NSCAS data, behavior dashboard data (whole school), and perceptual data from the 2022-2023 culture and climate surveys.

### List changes made to the Schoolwide Plan - if none, respond NA:

We felt as if we had many opportunties for family engagement and limited resources, so we decided to not hold another parent engagement night after the Digital Resources night on March 23. We originally included a Math night as well. The math activites will be done during classroom math time in May and sent home for practice in leiu of the Math night.

### **Meeting Minutes:**

We reviewed the 2022-2023 School-wide Title Plan

Each profiecent category of the rubric was read and the group reached consensus on whether or not our school was profiecent in each section. Once profiecency was established, we looked at the "advanced" category and used group consensus to determine if we qualified.

The group had prolonged disucssion around one two sections. The group discussed options of extending the school day even more next year with clubs and by expanding tutoring to include more students. There was also discussion about moving from two engagment nights to one for the 2022-2023 school year and all agreed. We decided to still do the math take-home lessons and send one home with each student in May instead of holding another engagement night.
