The character component of the application is based upon teacher and/or administrator evaluation. The service component involves 10 hours of volunteering in at least two different activities -- one of the activities in this area must be volunteering for an activity not associated with Burke High School.

You should receive a letter regarding your acceptance by late-March. A formal induction ceremony will be held on April 26, 2023.
