Class	Class Description
<b>Brain Builders</b>	Come play games after school in a fun club! You'll try exciting games like Niya, Tsuro of the Seas, Seven Dragons, Ticket to Ride, and card games like Skyjo and Cribbage. You'll learn how to play, think carefully, and have lots of fun with friends.
<b>Cheerleading</b>	Ready? Ok! Join the cheerleading team and learn fun cheers and dances moves. You'll practice new cheers and enjoy being part of a team.
<b>Competitive Robotics</b> (Gr. 4-6) <i>Prerequisite: Intro. to Robotics</i>	Students build and program radio-controlled robots and use them to compete in area competitions. <b><i>**Parent(s)/guardian(s) need to provide transportation to competitions.</i></b>
<b>Creation Station with iPad</b>	With lessons from Apple, you'll explore new apps on the iPad and build a better understanding of others, all while creating your own projects.
<b>Dance</b>	Get ready to move and have fun in the dance program! You will learn cool dance steps and different styles while practicing with friends.
<b>Gardening Club</b>	In the gardening club, you will discover how to grow your own plants and flowers! You'll plant seeds, take care of them, and watch them grow big and strong. You'll learn about bugs, soil, and how to help the Earth stay healthy.
<b>Green Team</b>	Join the Green Team and help protect the Earth! You will learn about recycling, composting, and keeping our school clean. Working with friends, you'll learn how to take care of nature and make your neighborhood a better place.

<b>Intro. to Robotics</b> (Gr. 3-6)	Get ready to explore the world of robots! You will learn how to build and program robots using fun tools and simple coding. You'll work with your classmates to solve problems and complete cool challenges.
<b>Invention Scouts</b>	Invention Scouts is a fun program where you build, explore, and create. You will solve problems, work with others, and even take things apart to see how they work!
<b>Mini Makers</b>	Let's get creative and crafty together! You'll use colors, paper, and glue to make fun projects that you can be proud of. Mini Makers is a great place to explore your imagination, have fun with friends, and make some crafts!
<b>Needlepoint</b>	You will learn how to sew colorful designs with thread and fabric. You will make pretty pictures and patterns while practicing your patience and focus. You will be guided step-by-step, and soon you'll be able to create your own special art.
<b>Omaha Henry Doorly Zoo</b>	Zoo staff will bring cool science experiments, art projects, and real zoo items to help you learn about animal types, habitats, and how everything in nature is connected. You'll even get to meet live animals like insects, spiders, reptiles, amphibians, and more!

<b>Roaring Readers</b>	In this after-school book club, you get to read fun stories and talk about them with others. You can share your favorite parts and listen to what others think.
<b>Snapology</b> (Gr. 3-4)	You'll build robots, try coding, and solve design challenges using LEGO® bricks, K'Nex, and other fun tools. While you play and explore, you will cool activities with science, technology, engineering, art, and math.
