<p>MTSS-B/Attendance: To reduce the percentage of suspensions from school from 8% to 5% each year until the 2025-26 school year.</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Staff implementation of the RULER Model (Charter, Mood Meter, Meta Moment, and blueprint). • Staff will reteach MTSS-B skills throughout the year as a refresher. • Teachers will use a 4 to 1 positive to corrective ratio when providing feedback to students. • Reinforce positive behavior with SOAR Cards for Students and Staff
