#### **AP IMPORTANT DATES AND TASKS: FALL 2025**

#### August 2025

- August 18th & August 19th: Registration for AP classes in AP Classroom begins. Students complete College Board digital account activation process using join codes given by teacher for EACH AP course
- Wednesday, August 20th: Burke's Advanced Academic Family Night on from 6:30 - 7:30pm. Students and families can come learn more about Advanced Placement and Dual Enrollment.

### September 2025

• Friday, September 26th: Deadline for students to register/sign up in My AP Classroom for EACH AP course

# October 2025

- Friday, October 17th: Deadline for students to indicate exam intentions in My AP account (YES or NO for exam) for EACH course they are in.
- Saturday, October 18th: Burke AP Coordinator changes all "undecided" exams to "no" in AP system
- Monday, October 27th Friday, October 31st: Burke AP Coordinator contacts students to confirm exam choices (students will receive one hard copy of their exams in one of their AP classes)

## November 2025

- Friday, November 7th: Last day to cancel an AP exam(s) without a \$40 fee unused/cancellation exam fee. Students MUST complete the "AP Exam Opt-Out" form.
- After November 7th, there is a \$40.00 fee to add an AP Exam (fall and yearlong classes only)

## December 2025

- Friday, December 12th: Deadline for students to request SSD testing accommodations (must have documented IEP or 504) for AP exams in May 2026 due to Ms. Nadine Reyes (Burke Counselor)
- •Requests for testing accommodations **after** the College Board deadline may not be approved in time for testing.

#### May 2026

- Monday, May 4th Friday May 15th, 2026: Students take AP Exams. See schedule on reverse side.
- Monday, May 18th Friday May 22nd, 2025: Late AP Exams; if approved by the College Board.
- Any student who registered for an AP exam(s) that fails to show up for their scheduled examination on the appointed date and time will **not** be allowed to take a late exam and will receive a **\$40.00** cancellation fee for EACH AP exam.
