

Common Questions and Answers: AP vs. DE

Question: Should I dual enroll?

Questions to consider:

- Do I have at least a 3.0 GPA?
- Am I prepared to have my Burke grade in the class also on an official college transcript?

ALSO: CONTACT the college/university you are considering (if you know itended major, also speak with department) and ASK:

- Do you accept dual enrollment credit?
- How will accept UNO, MCC, or Midland courses (state specific name and course number)
- Will I be considered a freshman regardless of the number of credits I bring in? (In other words, would I still be elgible for all freshman scholarships offered?)
- Would the credits I bring in be counted against the overall length/amount of any scholarship that he/she may receive?

Question: Should I take the AP Exam?

Questions to consider:

- Do I do well on standardized tests? (AP exams average three to four hours each)
- Am I willing to put in the extra time to study and review for the AP exam in addition to the course work load?

ALSO: CONTACT the college/university you are considering and ASK:

- What score does a student need to earn on the AP Exam for crdit, and what course credit would it be?

Items to consider:

- Credits may count toward the total number of hours attempted for purposes of scholarships and financial aid. Check specific scholarship requirements.
- Pre-professional students check requirements of professional schools. Some do not accept college credits taken while in high school. Some require specific grades and will not accept AP credit.

Questions to consider:

- What happens if I am not successful in the dual enrolled course (grades)? How will the AP exam help me?
- Will the credits earned from dual enrollment AND/OR the AP Exam apply to the programs, majors, and colleges/universities I am considering?
- How confident am I that I will earn the required AP Exam score needed for the programs, majors, and colleges/universities I am considering?
- Is the AP/DE course an area in which I am extremely interested and/or passionate about? Do I see myself studying this content after high school for an advanced degree?
