IMPORTANT INFORMATION Please read



1. All iPads will remain at school on Friday, October 6th.

2. We will begin swapping out old iPads for new ones on Monday, October 9th.

Each class will be called to a designated area at Dundee. We will collect the old iPad and hand the student a new iPad with a case. Students will keep their current charging cords.

3. If you have already returned the Voluntary Device Protection Plan for the 23-24 school year with \$20 attached, you do NOT need to complete another form. The coverage you purchased this year follows the student.

 If you have NOT returned the Voluntary Device Protection Plan with \$20 and would like the coverage, a new form on gold paper was sent home on Wednesday, September 27th.

 The \$20 protection plan for the 23-24 school year might be a good option compared to the replacement price of \$527 if the iPad is lost, stolen, or damaged.

6. Friday, October 6th will be the deadline if you choose to participate in the Device Protection Program for the 23-24 school year.

7. We hope to have ALL new iPads in student hands by the end of the day on October 10th.


To Our Dundee Community:


