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Mr. Erikson acknowledged the next item on the agenda. Ms. Carter gave a presentation of the 2nd quarter 2019 portfolio performance from AON Consulting and the Nebraska Investment Council report. The OSERS portfolio closed on June 30, 2019 at \$1,260 billion, an increase of \$17,948 million from first quarter 2019. The following are the performance returns for the indicated periods.

Ms. Carter indicated she engaged the Nebraska Investment Council and AON to review the manner of reporting of OSERS alternative investments. The concern was the reports were not showing the receipt of distributions from the legacy alternative investments as part of the quarterly reporting. AON Consulting agreed the inclusion of distributions received from the legacy alternative investments could be added to the quarterly reporting in the same manner as reported for NPERS alternative investments.

Ms. Carter also reviewed the AON Consulting Capital Markets report. This report indicated the consulting firm's expectation on overall asset class returns for the coming ten year and thirty year periods. Given the asset allocation of the overall portfolio managed by the Nebraska Investment Council, the annualized return (10 year forecast) is 6.2% with a standard deviation of 12.2%, and the annualized return (30 year forecast) is 6.7% with a standard deviation of 12.5%.

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Ms. Carter reviewed the financial statements and budget variance report for the month ending August 31, 2019. At the close, the unaudited valuation on the OSERS portfolio was \$1,305 billion. Ms. Carter reminded the Board these were unaudited financial statements and the investment return was a month in the rears. The audited financial statements for the fiscal year ending August 31, 2019 will be presented in December 2019.

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Ms. Carter gave a recap of the Better Together Coalition meeting held September 4, 2019. At the BTC meeting it was decided the District would engage the OSER actuary to analyze three

more options, which are: (1) the effects of moving the OSERS funding policy from four year smoothing to five year smoothing; (2) the effects of moving the year-end valuation report date from January 1 to July 1; and (3) the effects of imposing a 30-year cap on years of service with distribution of the employee contributions contributed from year 31 until retirement. Ms. Carter also noted, the facilitator for the BTC and she are trying to coordinate a meeting between two representatives of OSERS and two representatives of the OPS Board of Education to prepare for the upcoming Nebraska Legislative Retirement Committee hearing in November.

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The meeting then moved to the Executive Director's report. Ms. Carter reviewed for the board the following topics:

- The status of the LB 31 (2019) study through the Nebraska Public Employees' Retirement System (NPERS). She indicated the Director of NPERS sent an email the previous day with updates on the questions the NPERS staff has on the OSERS system
- The 2019 actuarial services RFP was issued on September 24, 2019 with a due date for responses of October 28, 2019
 - After discussion with the Board, it was determined Mr. Scott Herchenbach along with OSERS staff will review the responses received and make a recommendation to the Board of Trustees
- The 2019 audit of financial statements is in progress and field work is scheduled for later in October
- Tom Macdonald of Cavanaugh Macdonald has retired. Ed Koebel was named Chief Executive Officer; Todd Green and Alisa Bennett were named Presidents on the seven member board of manager for the firm
- The 2019 Medical COLA was paid on October 3, 2019 in accordance with NE Rev Stat sec. 79-9, 103(13)
 - The 2019 payment of medical COLA was \$371,949.70
 - Medical COLA does not transfer to the surviving beneficiary upon the death of the retiree
- An overview of the 2019 AON Consulting client conference

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Mr. Erikson then called for any trustee reports. Mr. Rea noted the recent National Council Teachers' Retirement webinar on Fiduciary Duties and also noted he would not be in attendance at the November Board of Trustees meeting. Mr. Purdy asked about attendance at the retirement workshops titled: New Employee Retirement Workshops. Ms. Carter noted there are more in attendance at the beginning of the school year than towards the end of the school year.

There being no new business, the meeting adjourned at 5:16 p.m.
