

7th Grade Registration

2021-2022 School Year

Instructions for successful completion:

1. Your classes need to add up to 11 points. Select courses to add up to 11 POINTS.
2. You can sign-up for:
 1. 1-point class meets for 45 minutes for 1 quarter
 2. 2-point class meets for 90 minutes for 1 quarter
 3. 4-point class meets for 90 minutes for 1 semester
3. If you are selected for Reading Skills (worth 4 points), you will select 7 points
4. If you are enrolling in Orchestra, Band, or Swing Choir (all worth 4 points) you will select 7 points
5. Follow the directions on YOUR registration form. Everyone's form is individualized.

Music Courses

CHORUS 7 (4 points)

Chorus meets every other day for 45 minutes for the entire year. Chorus 7 is available to seventh grade students who have a special interest and ability in choral singing. Daily participation, singing, and performance in the Winter and Spring Concerts are required to pass this class.

SWING CHORUS 7 (4 points)

Swing Chorus 7 meets every other day for 45 minutes for the entire year. Swing Chorus 7 is only available to students who auditioned in the spring semester (this course is listed on the top of your registration form).

BAND 7 (4 points)

Band 7 meets every other day for 45 minutes for the entire year. Band 7 is only available to students who have previous band experience (this course is listed on your top of your registration form).

ORCHESTRA 7 (4 points)

Orchestra 7 meets every other day for 45 minutes for the entire year. Orchestra 7 is only available to students who have previous strings experience (this course is listed on the top of your registration form).

MUSIC EXPLORATION 7 (1 point)

Music Exploration 7 meets every other day for 45 minutes for one quarter. Students use music reading skills to perform music on classroom instruments such as xylophone, hand bells, and guitar.

Art Courses

ART 7 (1 point)

Art 7 meets every other day for 45 minutes for one quarter. This course introduces students to the basic foundations of art elements and principles. Students work with a variety of media and explore basic processes and techniques, enhanced by the study of art from different periods and cultures.

ART STUDIO 7 (2 points)

Art Studio 7 meets every other day for 90 minutes for one quarter. This course teaches students to draw, makes prints, paint, and ceramics. Students work with a variety of media and explore processes and techniques, enhanced by the study of art movements from different periods and cultures throughout history.

Honors Courses

HONORS SPECIAL PROJECTS 7 (1 point)

Honors Special Projects 7 meets every other day for 45 minutes for one quarter. This course offers a wide variety of experiences that align with gifted and talented programming standards. Learning opportunities meet grade level objectives in problem-solving, critical thinking, creative thinking, inquiry, cultural proficiency, metacognition and affective skills.



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COMPUTER APPLICATIONS III (1 point)

Computer Applications III meets every other day for 45 minutes for one quarter. In computer applications students master the touch operation of keyboard characters using correct keyboarding techniques. Content coverage includes the use of individualized lessons with three basic parts: introduction of keys, practice material, and time tests. Word processing, spreadsheets, and databases are explored and created. Desktop publishing, presentations, and proper use of the Internet and e-mail are continued from basic skills previously learned.

CODING APPLICATIONS 7 (1 point)

Coding Applications 7 meets every other day for 45 minutes for one quarter. This course teaches the foundational concepts of programming using drag and drop blocks. This course includes exploration of careers in computer science. All lessons align to all relevant computer science standards.

TECHNOLOGY AND LIVING 7 (1 point)

Tech & Living 7 meets every other day for 45 minutes for one quarter. This course is an exploratory course that blends Industrial Technology and Family and Consumer Sciences curriculum. Students work cooperatively through multiple Technology and Living unit. These units range from computer-aided design (CAD), clothing, structures, foods, lasers, housing, electricity/electronics, consumerism, robotics, childcare, research and design and family. Students will explore career opportunities and the technological skills needed to pursue those careers.

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TECHNOLOGY PROJECTS 7 (2 points)

Technology Projects 7 meets every other day for 90 minutes for one quarter. Students develop and create projects with a focus on learning various software programs to create innovative projects.

DIGITAL MEDIA 7 (4 points)

Digital Media 7 meets every other day for 90 minutes for one semester. Students create digital projects using Word, PowerPoint, music creation, photography and video editing software. Students will create technology projects to demonstrate their skill level.

ROBOTICS 7 (4 points)

Robotics 7 meets every other day for 90 minutes for one semester. Using engineering and programming software, students work collaboratively to design, build, and test robotic equipment.

JAOEF 7 (4 points)

Jr. ACADEMY OF ECON AND FINANCE meets every other day for 90 minutes for one semester. This course introduces students to the Stock Market. Students will learn how to make sound financial decisions. Students will work through activities to learn about factors that affect income, create a spending and savings plan, and the effects of using credit.
