2. Support your child's learning—volunteer in their classroom; participate, as appropriate, in decisions related to their education, guide positive use of extracurricular time.
3. Make sure my child is at school every day and on time, unless he/she is ill.
4. Support our child by monitoring his/her progress, checking regularly for school communication, and ensuring that all homework is completed.
5. Work with the school to ensure that our child's academic, social, and physical needs are being met.
6. Maintain open communication with the school by asking questions about any areas of concern and informing the school about any pertinent student information that will help promote a productive learning environment.

### **As a student, I will**

1. Be at school every day and on time unless I am sick.
2. **Be safe** by serving as a positive role model to peers and others by following all school expectations in and out of school.
3. **Be accountable** for my own behavior.
4. **Be responsible** by respecting and cooperating with other students and coming to school each day prepared with completed schoolwork and an attitude to learn.
