

Nutrition Services

During the 2022-2023 school year, the district is participating in the Community Eligibility Provision (CEP). All students enrolled in an Omaha Public School where meals are provided will receive a healthy breakfast and lunch at no charge, regardless of income. No further action is required.

Breakfast –

- All students who wish to eat breakfast may do so at no cost.
- The cafeteria opens at 7:20 am and stops serving at 7:35 am.

Lunch –

- Any funds remaining in a student's account will automatically be carried over to the 2022-2023 school year unless parents/guardians notify Nutrition Services. Any carry over funds may be used to purchase a second meal or any ala carte items.
- A la carte items, snacks, or second meals will be sold separately.

Student Lunch Accounts –

- Parents may pay in advance for A la carte items, snacks, or second meals by depositing money into a student's cafeteria account. Money can be deposited any school day between 7:00 am and 1:00 pm in the Lewis and Clark cafeteria.
