Dear Omaha Public Schools Families,

We are excited to announce that the Omaha Public Schools will provide Advanced Academic support to pay for all tuition and fees for students who wish to enroll in Dual Enrollment courses. The district will also pay the fee to take the Advanced Placement Exam in May for all Advanced Placement courses. Our goal is that more students take advantage of these opportunities.

The Omaha Public Schools is proud to offer many advanced academic offerings for students in each of our high schools. Dual Enrollment and Advanced Placement Exams provide students the opportunity to earn college credit or college placement while they are in high school. Students who graduate with college credits are often able to save significant amounts of time and money when they enter college.

Students will begin enrolling for both Dual Enrollment and Advanced Placement Exams over the next few weeks. Representatives from partner Dual Enrollment institutions will visit schools soon to help students with enrollment procedures. This fall, Advanced Placement teachers will work with students to register for Advanced Placement Exams.

AP & Dual Enrollment Frequently Asked Questions

Q: Is there a process to sign up to take the Advanced Placement Exam?

A: Yes, you will work with your Advanced Placement teacher and enroll in the AP Classroom (myap.collegeboard.org) to indicate if you are or are not ordering an exam for the 2023-24 exam cycle.

Q: Do I have to take the Advanced Placement Exam?

A: No. However, **ALL** Advanced Placement students will be required to take a cumulative final, which is either the Advanced Placement exam created by the College Board **OR** an Omaha Public Schools cumulative exam.

Q: Do I need to register for dual enrollment to earn college credits?

A: Yes, you need to follow the application guidelines for Metropolitan Community College, Midland University, and/or University of Nebraska Omaha to register for the courses you are eligible to take at your high school. *Courses are eligible based on teacher credentials.

Q: What is the Access College Early (ACE) Scholarship?

A: The Access College Early (ACE) Scholarship program pays tuition and mandatory fees for qualified, low-income high school students to enroll in college courses from Nebraska colleges or universities, either through dual enrollment or early enrollment agreements with these institutions.

Q: If I fill out the EBF (Educational Benefits Form) and qualify, do I need to fill out the Access College Early (ACE) Scholarship to cover my dual enrollment?

A: Yes, please fill out the EBF each year to see if you qualify for benefits to cover many opportunities. This is important because many entities are working together to provide funding to make Advanced Academics low or no cost to all families. Then, Mr. Custard and Dr. Gutierrez will work with you to complete the ACE Scholarship. You can complete the application online at <https://ccpe.nebraska.gov/ACE>

Q: Will I receive a bill for Advanced Placement and or Dual Enrollment costs?
